

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
VILLAGE OF WALDO FLOODPLAIN ORDINANCE AMENDMENT**

PUBLIC NOTICE is given to all persons in the Village of Waldo that a public hearing will be held on November 12, 2018 at approximately 6:15 p.m. (immediately following the public hearing on the Proposed 2019 General Fund Budget). The meeting will be held in the Waldo Village Hall at 810 West Second Street, Waldo. The purpose of the public hearing is to solicit comments on proposed floodplain zoning ordinance and/or map revisions that are required by state and federal law. These revisions govern development in mapped floodplain areas. The proposed revisions are on file in the office of the Waldo Village Clerk.

The proposed regulations are intended to protect life, health and property in floodplain areas and will govern uses permitted in mapped floodplains. Activities such as dredging, filling, excavating and construction of buildings are generally allowed, but may be restricted according to which flood zone the property is in. A copy of the proposed ordinance will be on file and open for public inspection in the office of the Waldo Village Clerk for a period of two weeks prior to this public hearing.
