MINUTES OF THE WALDO WATER & SEWER UTILITY BOARD MONDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2021 IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE VILLAGE BOARD MEETING

DPW Mike Kitzerow had finished exercising all the water system valves. OIC Neerhof also explained that because of what had happened in Flint MI, the DNR is now requiring an inventory of all water materials used in the Village. He is getting quotes from two companies that will inventory resident's piping. The second half of lead/copper testing will be in late October or early November. The Village's lab results were all within required range.
- 6. Trustee Hintz motioned to approve vouchers 8935-8942 in the amount of \$24,649.83. Trustee Madgwick seconded the motion. The motion carried. Trustee Bunnow motioned to approve the September utility Treasurer's report. Trustee Hammarlund seconded. The motion carried.
- 7. There was no correspondence.
- 8. There were no updates from the board.
- 9. The Utility Board worked through the 2022 proposed utility budget.
