 - f. Water tower inspection. Inspection was good except it was found that the mixer was broken. Lane Tank will try and repair it on Friday.
- 5. Review and Approve Monthly Vouchers and Treasurer's Report: Trustee Hintz motioned to approve paying vouchers 9174-9181 in the amount of \$9,316.79. Trustee Hammarlund seconded the motion.
