

Waldo Residents:

The Village Board has made some changes to the garbage/recycling pick up in the Village due to misuse of the services offered. Any items that do not follow the guidelines will not be picked up by JD Trucking. Also, all recycling that is placed in bags or left out on non-recycling weeks will not be picked up. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the Village Office at (920) 528-8121.

**Items NOT accepted at the curb:**

- **Metal:** Scrap metal can be taken to JD Trucking drop off locations, free of charge.
- **Electronic Waste:** Electronics can be taken to JD Trucking drop off locations, fees do apply.
- **Organic Waste:** Excessive food waste, Animal Carcasses, Pumpkins, Live Christmas trees, Grass clippings, Tree branches/brush, and other organic waste can be deposited in the compost pile at the Waldo JD Trucking drop off location, free of charge.
- **Liquid Paint:** Dry water-based paint is accepted. If you need advice on how to dry excess paint, please let us know. Oil based paint needs to be disposed at a Household Hazardous Waste drop off collection.
- **Drain Oil:** Oil and other petroleum products can be taken to JD Trucking drop off locations, a small fee may apply
- **Tires:** Tires are not accepted at the drop-off location. We recommend contacting a local mechanic to dispose of them.
- **Construction/Remodeling waste:** Resident/Contractor are required to dispose of items. A dumpster can be rented, fees apply. **\*\*New Change\*\***
- **Bulky Items:** furniture, exercise equipment, artificial trees, appliances, grills, mattresses, box springs, vacuums, etc. Bulky items can be dropped off at the Waldo location, fees do apply. **\*\*New Change\*\***
