

SEASONAL BILLING INFORMATION:

The Village Board approved moving to seasonal utility billing. What this means for you, is that your sewer charges for the months of May 15-September 15 will be calculated, using your average water usage from January-April. The village will no longer be using deduct meters. The calculation will be automatic for all residents.

The example below is not reflective of any one account. Your amounts will be based off of your individual usage. Residential summer bill example:

The resident used 2,500 gallons of water in January, 2,200 gallons in February, 1,800 gallons in March, and 2,000 gallons in April. The average usage for the resident is 2,125 gallons. The example below is for the month of June.

The resident has the flat rate costs of \$10.26 & \$50.00 (those numbers don't change for either billing type).

Using seasonal billing, the resident is only charged sewer usage on the average 2,125 gallons, instead of the 7,000 gallons used.

If the water usage during the summer months is ever less than the average, the resident will only be charged the actual usage.

Water usage rate: \$2.87/1,000 gallons

Sewer usage rate: \$7.50/1,000 gallons
