## TAX COLLECTION-VILLAGE OF WALDO

Tax bills will be mailed from Sheboygan County to property owners by December 16.

The first installment or full payment is due January 31st.

Payment options include:

- Mail to Village of Waldo, PO Box 202, Waldo, WI 53093. If postmarked on or before 12/31/2024, payment will be credited in 2024. To receive a receipt, include a self-addressed stamped envelope.
- <u>Drop Box</u> is available at the Village Office, 810 W Second St. The box is just to the left of the office door. To receive a receipt, include a self-addressed stamped envelope. If payment is in the drop box by December 31<sup>st</sup>, it will be credited in 2024.
- Credit Card payment at www.allpaid.com. There is a 2.95% service fee added by Allpaid.
- <u>In-person</u> payment accepted Monday-Thursday from 8 a.m.-4 p.m. Overpayment refunds of more than \$3.00 will be mailed within 7 business days. The Village office will be closed December 24, 25, 31, and January 1.

\*\*Reminder that receipts are not automatically sent. If you are wanting a receipt and are not paying in person, a self-addressed stamped envelope is required. Receipts can be emailed.\*\*

## **DOG LICENSES**

All dogs within the Village of Waldo are required to be licensed annually. Licenses can be purchased at the time of tax payment. If paying by check, separate checks are needed.

\$7 Neutered Male or Spayed Female \$14 Un-neutered Male or Un-spayed Female

Provide this information to request a license:

- 1. Proof of current rabies vaccination
- 2. Owner's name, address, & phone number
- 3. Dog's name, color, breed, and gender
- 4. A Self-addressed stamped envelope is required if not paying in-person in the Village Office Dog Licenses are due by March 31st, 2025. Any license obtained as of April 1, 2025, will incur a \$15 late fee.
