ORDINANCE NO. 2026-06**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER A209 – CEMETERY BYLAWS, § A209-8
CHARGE FOR PLOTS**

WHEREAS, the Village of Waldo Village Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to modernize the administration of municipal fees; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to establish a consistent process for adjusting fees through a separately adopted Village Fee Schedule rather than embedding specific dollar amounts within Village ordinances; and

WHEREAS, such a structure will allow the Village to more efficiently review and update fees as needed without requiring frequent ordinance amendments;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Waldo, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: AMENDMENT TO § A209-8

Section § A209-8 of the Village of Waldo Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ A209-8. Charge for plots.

A. The Village of Waldo hereby establishes a fee structure for cemetery plots, burial services, staking, monument setting, and all related cemetery services. Fees for all cemetery services, including resident and non-resident rates, shall be established by resolution of the Village Board and maintained in the official Village of Waldo Fee Schedule, as may be amended from time to time.

The Village Clerk shall administer and apply the fee schedule established by the Village Board.

B. Eligibility for resident rates shall be based on the following residency criteria:

1. Current residency within the Village of Waldo at time of purchase; or
2. Ten (10) consecutive years of prior residency in the Village of Waldo.

C. Any purchaser who does not meet the criteria set forth in subsection B(1) or B(2) shall be classified as a non-resident and charged the non-resident rate established by Village Board resolution.

D. It is the responsibility of the purchaser to provide proof of residency at or prior to the time of purchase.

SECTION 2: REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS

Any and all ordinance provisions establishing specific fee amounts within § A209-8 that are inconsistent with this amendment are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Ordinance is found to be unlawful or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by the Village Board and publication/posting as required by law.
