OUTDOOR WARNING SIREN DISCONTINUED

The Village Board has voted to discontinue use of the Village's outdoor warning siren.

The existing siren must be activated manually at the site and cannot currently be activated remotely by Sheboygan County dispatch. Because of the age of the system and the potential cost to upgrade or replace it, the siren will no longer be used.

FOR SEVERE WEATHER OR EMERGENCY WARNINGS.**

WAYS TO STAY INFORMED

1. SIGN UP FOR SHEBOYGAN COUNTY ALERTS

Sheboygan County uses RAVE/Smart911 for emergency notifications.

2. NOAA WEATHER RADIO

Consider a NOAA Weather Radio with an alert feature, especially for overnight warnings.

3. CELL PHONE ALERTS

Make sure Wireless Emergency Alerts (WEA) are enabled on your cell phone.

4. OTHER SOURCES

Use a trusted weather app and local television or radio as additional warning methods.

Severe weather can occur at any time, including overnight. Please have more than one reliable way to receive warnings.
